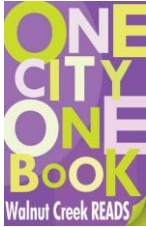

In 1939, Rossmoor resident Susan Hochschild was just eight years old and living in her native Vienna, Austria, when her family, recognizing the imminence of war, arranged to have her shuttled to the safety of England via Kindertransport. War broke out in Austria just a few months later.

Hochschild and two other local women - Doreen Ainscough and Paula Boswell -- will share their personal and very different experiences as children who lived in Europe during World War II. The discussion is one of the community events for this year's **One City, One Book: Walnut Creek Reads** program, which features the book, "The Guernsey Literary and Potato Peel Pie Society."

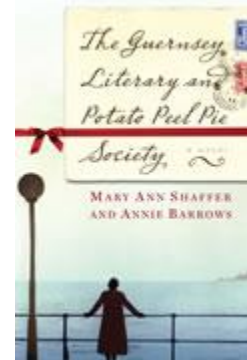
